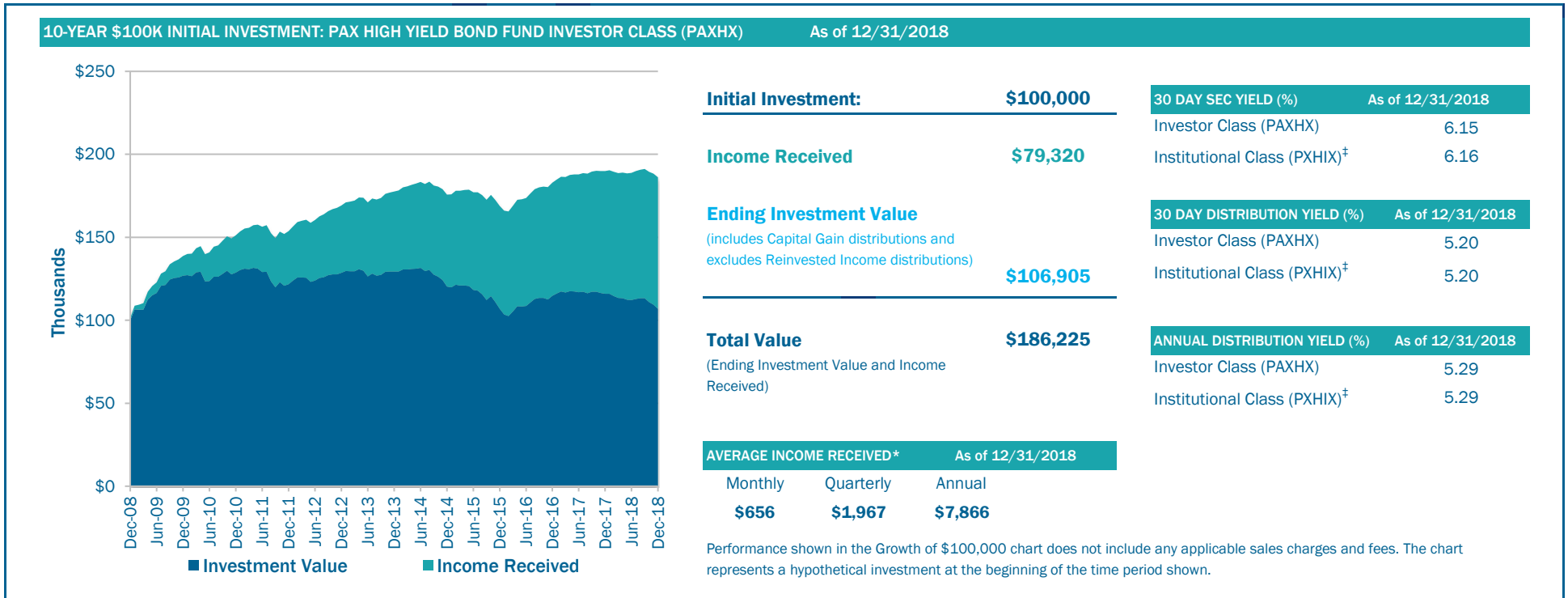


For investors seeking income
